Rules of ALA Volunteer Girls State

1. No citizen of Girls State shall be permitted to leave the campus of MTSU after registration, except in the case of emergency. Permission must be granted by the Director or Chairwoman of ALA VGS.
2. No one is allowed to be on campus alone.
3. Citizens will show respect to and pledge the American flag and will show reverence to God and country.
4. All citizens and staff members will be treated courteously, with respect and cooperation.
5. No citizen will be allowed to smoke or consume alcoholic beverages while at Girls State.
6. Citizens may NOT have any visitors while at Girls State.
7. Citizens must attend and must be prompt at ALL meals, assemblies and meetings.
8. Each citizen is responsible for the contents, neatness and condition of her room and accountable for the University property contained therein. All University campus rules will be observed and all University property must be protected and respected.
9. Any citizen who is ill or injured must report her condition to her counselor and then go immediately to the VGS nurse.
10. Name badges must be worn for identification at all times while at Girls State.
11. No pre-prepared campaign material will be permitted.
12. Cell Phones, MP3 players, PDAs and iPods are not allowed at VGS during any scheduled events (i.e. assemblies, meetings or walking between activities). They only are permitted in the dorm when there are no structured activities.
